

Funeral and memorial services are still taking place in Hamburgs cemeteries. The advice is designed to assist members who are attending or involved in organising funerals in Hamburg during coronavirus pandemic. The maximum number on attendees depends on the incidence rate. Please follow the regulations of FHH (Freie und Hansestadt Hamburg)

Incidence Rate > 100

- a. Number of attendees at funeral services, memorial ceremonies
 - i. indoors: the number of attendees will be determined by the size of the area, the number permitted will be a maximum of 30 people.
 - ii. Outdoors: Maximum 30 people
 - iii. 30 attendees means
 1. This maximum limit does not include anyone working at the event eg. Morticians, pallbearer and children under 14 years are neither included
 2. The maximum limit does include vaccinated and recovered people
- b. Number of attendees during the washing the body of the dead person as a ritual: 3 people are permitted: this limit includes the mortician, the imam and an accompanying person
- c. Number of attendees at accompanied cremation: 3 people , but this limit does not include anyone working at the event
- d. Numbers of attendees at taking farewell: Members of one household or maximum two people from different households. This does not include the mortician, if they take farewell at the open coffin in a chapel: please keep a distance of 1,5metres and do not touch the death person
- e. Please also follow all current corona regulations given by the FHH and hygiene measures presented by the HF.

2) Incidence Rate 50-99

- a. Number of attendees at funeral services, memorial ceremonies
 - i. indoors: the number of attendees will be determined by the size of the area, the number permitted will be a maximum of 50 people.
 - ii. Outdoors: Maximum 50 people
 - iii. 50 attendees means
 1. This maximum limit does not include anyone working at the event eg. Morticians, pallbearer and children under 14 years are neither included
 2. The maximum limit does include vaccinated and recovered people
- b. Number of attendees during the washing the body of the dead person as a ritual: 3 people are permitted: this limit includes the mortician, the imam and an accompanying person
- c. Number of attendees at accompanied cremation: 3people , but this limit does not include anyone working at the event
- d. Numbers of attendees at taking farewell: Members of one household or maximum two people from different households. This does not include the mortician, if they take farewell at the open coffin in a chapel: please keep a distance of 1,5 meters and do not touch the death person
- e. Please also follow all current corona regulations given by the FHH and hygiene measures presented by the HF.

3) Incidence Rate < 50

- a. Number of attendees at funeral services, memorial ceremonies
 - i. indoors: the number of attendees will be determined by the size of the area, the number permitted will be a maximum of 200 people.
 - ii. Outdoors: Maximum 200 people
 - iii. 200 attendees means
 - 1. This maximum limit does not include anyone working at the event eg. Morticians, pallbearer and children under 14 years are neither included
 - 2. The maximum limit does include vaccinated and recovered people
- b. Number of attendees during the washing the body of the dead person as a ritual: 3 persons are permitted: this limit includes the mortician, the imam and a accompanying person
- c. Number of attendees at accompanied cremation: 5people , but this limit does not include anyone working at the event
- d. Numbers of attendees at taking farewell: Members of one household or maximum two people from different households. This does not include the mortician, if they take farewell at the open coffin in a chapel: please keep a distance of 1,5metres and do not touch the death person
- e. Please also follow all current corona regulations given by the FHH and hygiene measures presented by the HF.
